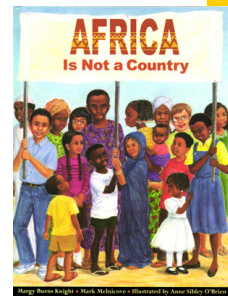
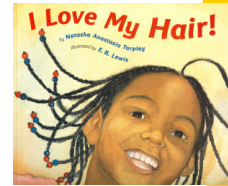
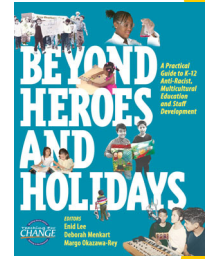
More than a bookstore: author dialogues and professional development

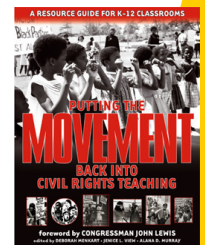
